Students read a book about 100% Accountable to 3rd grade elementary students.



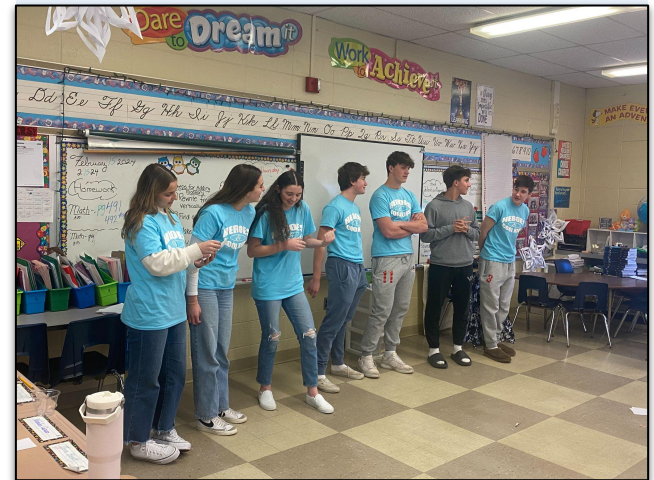
