World Language Offerings

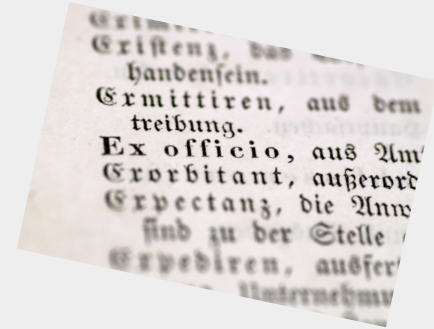
These classes fulfill the World Language requirement. One year is required for graduation, and 2 or more years is recommended for students that will pursue a post-secondary degree.

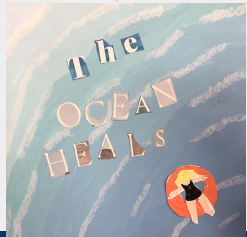
