SEPT-NOV



- Take PSAT/NMSQT
- Financial Aid Night - Seniors
- Meet with college reps at WHS

DEC-FEB



- PSAT/NMSQT scores released
- [Collegeboard.org](https://collegeboard.org)
- Log into SCOIR & become familiar
- Complete SCOIR Career Assessment
- Junior Postsecondary Meetings - turn in your resume

FEB-APRIL



- Senior year scheduling
- Take SAT/ACT
- Ask teachers for recommendation letters (2)
 - Complete Teacher Brag Sheet
- Attend college fairs/research schools

APRIL-JUNE



- Visit colleges (spring break) - refine college list
- Potential DI/DII athletes register-NCAA Eligibility Center
- AP Testing (if applicable)
- Complete Counselor Brag Sheet (students & parents)

SUMMER



- Continue to visit colleges
- Begin to finalize college list
- Access college applications
 - Create a Common App account
- Look at college deadlines
- Work on CA essays & supplemental essays

SEPT-DEC



- Meet with college reps at WHS
- Continue working on applications
- Submit FAFSA
- Pay attention to college deadlines
- Submit applications online, update SCOIR, & submit Senior Application Form to your school counselor
- Submit SAT/ACT if needed

DEC-MARCH



- ED/EA & Rolling college application decisions released
- Submit remaining applications
- Mid-year reports sent to colleges **if requested**
- Apply for scholarships - see website

APRIL-MAY



- College admissions decisions released
- May 1st National Decision Day/Deposit Day
- Senior Exit Survey - update college attending in SCOIR
