TITLE: EXPLORE ACADEMIC AND CREATIVE HEIGHTS (EACH) COORDINATOR

REPORTS TO: Building Principal and Director of Curriculum K-5

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. The EACH coordinator(s) provide(s) identified students with a challenging enrichment program. He/she collects data, including grades and teacher recommendations, to identify children and, with the other members of the EACH Committee*, selects approximately ten percent of the school population.
- The coordinator meets once a week with students and introduces them to topics and areas of study in which he/she may develop a sincere interest.
- 3. The culminating experience is an evening presentation for parents, which is facilitated by the coordinator(s).
- 4. The coordinator(s) meet no more than four times per year as a group with the Director of Curriculum.

*The EACH Committee is comprised of the coordinators, the Curriculum Director and at least one other administrator.

NOTE: Maximum number of students will be eighteen (18) for one teacher. If more than eighteen students are involved, a second teacher will be hired at the agreed rate and the total number of students will be split equally between the two teachers.

TERMS OF Contact Hours (52 hours plus 30 hours prep time for a total of 82 hours):

EMPLOYMENT: The program will take place the 2nd and 3rd marking periods.

45 instructional hours, once a week from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m.

2 hours evening presentation 30 hours of preparation time

1 1/4 hours per marking period to meet after school with EACH Committee (planning begins during the

first marking period)
