REPORTS TO: Principal

QUALIFICATIONS: A State of New Jersey teacher's certificate or substitute teacher's certificate obtained

from the County Superintendent of Schools.

JOB GOAL: To enable each child to purse his education as smoothly and completely as possible in

the absence of his regular teacher.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Reports to the Principal upon arrival 15 minutes before the official school opening.

- 2. Review with the Principal, unit chairman, or department head all plans and schedules to be following during the teaching day.
- 3. Assumes responsibility for overseeing pupil behavior in class and during lunch and recess periods.
- 4. Writes a note about work completed at the end of each teaching day and leaves it for the regular classroom teacher.
- 5. Checks with the office at the conclusion of the teaching day and verifies whether or not his/her services will be required on the next teaching day.
- 6. Performs other duties as delegated by the Principal.
