Please be advised that no medications (topical, oral, or parenteral) will be administered by anyone other than the certified school nurse, or in her absence, a substitute school nurse. The following is a list of approved medications that are used in our district's health rooms:

Triple Antibiotic Ointment
Bacitracin Ointment
Neosporin Ointment
Desitin
Calamine Lotion
Ivy Dry
Benadryl
Vaseline
Epinephrine
Narcan
Acetaminophen ***
Ibuprofen ***

***Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen may be administered from the health office by the school nurse with written parental consent for mild to moderate pain or fever greater than 100.4

If, for any reason, you do not wish your child to be treated with these approved medications, please notify your building school nurse, in writing, of this request.
