

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO KINDERGARTEN SEPTEMBER 2022

It is the policy of Wall Township Public School District to require immunizations mandated through the New Jersey State Sanitary code, Chapter 14. These requirements are applicable to all children attending New Jersey schools.

Specifically:

- 1. **DTaP**: A total of 4 doses with one of these doses on or after the 4th birthday OR any 5 doses†
- 2. **POLIO**: A total of 3 doses with one of these doses given on or after the 4th birthday OR any 4 doses‡
- 3. MMR: Two (2) doses§
- 4. **HEPATITIS B**: Three (3) doses
- 5. **VARICELLA:** One (1) dose <u>OR</u> proof of disease immunity
- 6. **TUBERCULOSIS**: Mantoux intradermal skin test to screen for exposure to tuberculosis **may** be required under certain circumstances

†DTaP: Children who previously attended child care/preschool should have received 4 doses since the requirement to receive the fourth birthday booster dose (5th dose) does not apply until the child attends Kindergarten. However, if one of these 4 doses was given on or after the 4th birthday, this child will not need an additional dose for Kindergarten. Alternatively, any 5 doses are acceptable.

‡ <u>Polio:</u> Children who previously attended child care/preschool should have 3 doses since the requirement to receive the fourth birthday booster dose (4th dose) does not apply until the child attends Kindergarten. However, if one of these 3 doses was given on or after the 4th birthday, this child will not need an additional dose for Kindergarten. Alternatively, any 4 doses are acceptable

§ MMR: A child is required to receive two doses of measles, one dose of mumps, and one dose of rubella once he/she enters Kindergarten. Since single antigen (separate components of the vaccine) is not readily available, most children will have two MMR vaccines
