Dear Students and Parents.

Mid-Term Exams are scheduled for January 21st - January 27th. The schedule is listed below. Students are required to be present and on time for all exams at the scheduled exam time. If you are sick on the morning of an exam or have any other emergency, your parent/guardian must call Ms. Berardo, 732-556-2047 and email your teacher as well. Make-up exams will be taken during the scheduled make-up exam day on Monday, January 27th unless other arrangements are made with your teacher to make up the exam earlier. In the case of an extended illness, arrangements will be made through the school counseling department. In all other situations, the student shall receive a "0" for a missed exam. Your teachers will provide study guides for each exam and review the exam schedule with you.

Please note: In the event of inclement weather and school is closed, the exam schedule will commence on the next day of school. If the district has a delayed opening during the exam schedule, exams **will be** administered and lunch will be served.

Make-Up Exam Day. If a student has an excused absence from an exam, the student should make arrangements with the classroom teacher to schedule the make-up exam. If a student needs assistance, the student should contact their school counselor.

Tuesday, January 28, 2025

First day of MP 3 - an "E" day (students will attend all classes for 41 minute blocks)

Transportation:

Buses will pick up students at the regularly scheduled morning times and depart school at 11:45 a.m.

Vocational Classes:

Vocational students are required to be present for their scheduled exams and will be excused from vocational school on those days only. On days when they have no exams, they must attend their vocational program; transportation will be provided. Vocational students should check with their vocational bus drivers and inform them of their schedule. The Guidance department will send notice to the vocational schools as well.

SENIOR FINAL EXAM EXEMPTIONS

There are no exemptions from <u>mid-term exams</u>. In the case of <u>semester courses</u>, where the exam is actually a <u>final exam</u>, seniors who have earned at least a 91 average for marking periods one and two and neither marking period average is below an 88, <u>will be exempt from the semester course exam</u>.
