Dear WTPS Family,

We are hours away from polls opening Tuesday, when Wall Township voters can make their voices heard. Together voters will decide whether or not key improvements will be made across all schools with the benefits that come from bond funding.

The WTPS Board of Education worked hard to formulate a plan where the most critical needs have been strategically packaged into two ballot questions.

If passed:

- Question 1 will have **no impact on the current property tax rate** and addresses essential improvements such as roof replacements, HVAC upgrades, and more.
- Question 2, on the same ballot, will have an increase of \$5/month for a home assessed at the average in Wall Township. This question includes other important projects, including additional improvements to our schools and Wall High School's athletic facilities.

We strongly encourage the community to get out and vote on Tuesday. Your participation matters!

Make sure to know when, where, and how to vote on Tuesday, December 13:

- To vote in person: Polls will be open from 6 AM to 8 PM at the sites listed here.
- **To vote by mail**: If you received a Vote By Mail ballot, it must be postmarked before or on December 13 to count. You can also hand-deliver your ballot to the *Monmouth County Board of Elections*. Ballots will not be accepted at in-person polling locations.
- If you are told you cannot vote for any reason, request a provisional ballot. A provisional ballot allows your vote to be counted once the mailed ballots are processed and your voter eligibility is double-checked and confirmed.

When results are available, they will be posted to our referendum website (wallpublicschools.org/vision) and our social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram).

Please stay informed and remember to cast your vote on Tuesday!
